Dear Mr. Wilson:

Your letter dated January 24, 1977 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

From the information supplied in your letter, your organization may have been a political committee with respect to a public question in the November election, with an obligation to file pre-election and post-election reports, but no annual report.

Your letter deals also with annual reporting requirements as a political information organization. By virtue of litigation in the State of New Jersey, the provisions of the Act with respect to annual reports by political information organizations has been held unconstitutional. While that decision is on appeal, no enforcement proceedings are being taken by the Commission with respect to any political information organizations. For this reason, there is no present requirement that your organization file any annual report with the Commission.

In view of this determination, we have not reached the further question whether the activities of your group would constitute a political information organization, but for the fact of the court ruling.
