Dear Mr. Reiner:

The Attorney General has asked me to reply to your letter of October 16, 1987 which concerns whether the Sea-Land Corporation is subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:34-45. Please be advised that we have had a number of requests recently concerning the scope of that statute and are in the process of reviewing our previous opinions in this matter as well as reviewing those situations not covered by those opinions.

Given the facts as stated in your correspondence to the Election Law Enforcement Commission, it would appear that Sea-Land would not fall into the prohibition of the statute as you suggest in your letter. In any event, we will be responding more formally to the Election Law Enforcement Commission on this and other matters in the near future.
